

TANGANYIKA POSTAL STATIONERY

GEORGE V POSTAL CARDS

The Mandated Territory of Tanganyika issued two postal cards in 1927 featuring the portrait of King George Fifth.

Both were designed and printed by De la Rue of London in 1926.

No records exist of numbers printed or issued.

SINGLE POSTAL CARD

Issued at fifteen cents which paid the internal, Empire and foreign rates for postal cards.

The exhibit features mint, specimens and usage.

REPLY PAID POSTAL CARD

Issued with an attached reply-paid card which guaranteed return postage to Tanganyika from U.P.U. signatories.

The exhibit features De la Rue archival plate proofs; one notated “Approved for Wording”, the other plate proof of the issued card.
